

Berlin Urban Wildlife Tour: 14th – 18th March 2019

Cost: £800 per person. Deposit: £100

Maximum Number: 4



Itinerary

Thursday 14th March – First Day

Scheduled flights are from London and Manchester, leaving early evening. We meet at **Schonfeld** airport late evening. We then take a transfer to our hotel of around 40 minutes.

Friday 15th – Sunday 17th March

We have 3 full days photography. We visit a range of locations to photograph wild Kestrel, Goshawk, Hooded crow and possibly Buzzard. Other subjects include Red Squirrel and woodland birds such as Nuthatch and Jay. We will re-visit locations that we agree, as a group, provide the best opportunities.

In the field Photography:

All of our photography is done in the field, mostly in urban locations. Therefore there may be other people around but this is very unlikely to affect our photography. Woodland sites offer shelter whilst other locations can be very open. Please dress appropriately.

Goshawks

Please note: whilst Goshawks can be seen and photographed from public locations, they are still protected by law and must be treated with respect. Please follow my guidelines to reduce disturbance to these majestic birds.



Monday 18th March – Last Day

An early morning start for the transfer and flight home from Schonfeld airport.

Equipment Required

Lenses from 400mm – 600mm. A tripod with gimbal head is useful if you have a big lens. However, we can do quite a lot of walking so it would be beneficial to have at least the option of a lighter lens for hand-holding or possibly with a monopod. Please ask if you're unsure.

Accommodation

We stay at [Motel One-Potsdamer Platz](#) This contemporary stylish, 4 star hotel is located at the Mall of Berlin, a 2-minute walk from Potsdamer Platz U-bahn station and 4 km from the iconic Berlin Wall. The sleek rooms come with complimentary Wi-Fi, flat-screen TVs and desks, as well as balconies. En suite granite bathrooms feature rainfall showerheads. Rooms are on a single basis but if couples wish to share then a discount can be applied. Please ask for prices.

Transport

We largely use the S-Bahn and U-Bahn to get around Berlin. This provides the quickest and easiest form of transport. It can be very busy during rush hour.

Food

All meals are included. We eat breakfast at our hotel unless provided with a packed breakfast to take away. Evening meals are taken in a local restaurant when we return from our day's photography. Lunch will be in appropriate cafes/ restaurants; depending on our plans we may need to eat sandwiches on the go. Many dishes are similar to the UK but you might want to try the curried sausage... Or not.

What's Included in the Cost

All accommodation; all transport in Berlin; all meals (except on first night and last morning); airport transfers; tuition as required. **Additional costs:** external flight; all drinks. Plus any personal extras.

Climate

Mid-March temperatures are likely to be around 5 degrees. Early mornings can be colder. Weather can be changeable. Think similar to the UK.

Intensity

There is some walking involved – this can be up to approx. 3 miles but the majority is on very flat ground.



Bad Weather

In bad weather we will still aim to visit our locations. If photography time is reduced due to bad weather (as a last resort) we will spend more time reviewing our images and discussing photo technique.

Potential Hazards

There is no extreme terrain or environment on this tour. However we do need to take care when crossing busy roads and using U-Bahn and S-Bahn stations and trains.

The city of Berlin

The evenings will be free so you have plenty of opportunity to explore Berlin if you wish. Maps are available. Perhaps consider staying an extra day to relax and enjoy the city.

Payment

A deposit can be paid via Paypal or Cheque. Please contact me to pay the **balance** either by **cheque** or **bank transfer**.

Insurance

You must have adequate travel insurance as in the **Terms & Conditions**. Please also ensure your camera equipment is insured.
